FIGURE 1.1 - BANKING ACTIVITY - DEPOSITS




FIGURE 1.2 - BANKING ACTIVITY - LOANS



FIGURE 2 - REMITTANCE



FIGURE 3 - AUTO SALES



FIGURE 4 - VISITOR ARRIVAL



FIGURE 5 - AVERAGE CNMI HOTEL DAILY RATE



FIGURE 6 - AVERAGE CNMI HOTEL OCCUPANCY RATE



FIGURE 7 - BUSINESS GROSS REVENUE (BRG) REPORTED



FIGURE 8 - GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES



FIGURE 9 - GENERAL FUND REVENUE (TAXES AND FEES COLLECTED)



(IN THOUSANDS)**



FIGURE 11 - EXPORTS



FIGURE 13.1 - COMMERCIAL PHONE LINES




FIGURE 13.2 - RESIDENTIAL PHONE LINES




FIGURE 13.3 - COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL PHONE LINES (TOTALS)



FIGURE 14.1 - NUMBER OF BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED




FIGURE 14.2 - VALUES OF BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED (IN MILLIONS)


